

GOALS DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

The educational philosophy of the District emphasizes the schools exist to assist each student to develop to his/her fullest potential. To ensure that this philosophy and accompanying objectives are maintained, a formal goal-setting process will be established by the Board. Using this process, the Board of Education will adopt goals for school improvement annually.

District level and school level goals will be developed. District level goals will encompass all phases of improvement including educational programs, operating facilities and maintenance, and Board/Administrative functions. School level goals will relate to student performance outcomes. Information from all district personnel, the Board of Education, related outside agencies, and the general public can be incorporated into this goal-setting process.

Priorities in the district budget will reflect district goals adopted for that year. Each year, district level goals will be adopted by the Board of Education by September 15th. School goals will be developed by building staff and reported to the Board by October 15th of each year.

The District will develop a school performance report, which shall be published in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes. The format of the report shall conform with D.P.I. directives.
