

SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

- a. Students with disabilities will be transported on the regular buses if they are able to get on and off of the bus with little or no assistance and do not require any special care or supervision while on the bus.
- b. The District will provide appropriate transportation and bus supervision for students with disabilities who cannot ride the regular school bus.
- c. The Board of Education may authorize transportation for students that are under a physician's care and who cannot make other arrangements to get to school. A letter from a physician stating the reasons necessary for special transportation must be on file in the transportation office prior to transportation being provided. This letter must be renewed yearly if continued transportation is to be provided.
- d. The District will provide, for any District student with an identified exceptional education need, transportation necessary to implement the terms of the IEP, or which might be required by federal law, state law, or rules of the Department of Public Instruction.
