

FACILITIES PLANNING

The School District of Brodhead School Board is responsible for the regular operation and orderly development of its physical plant. For this reason, the Board will concern itself with both short and long-range planning as it relates to the properties of the School District of Brodhead. The Superintendent and his/her Administrative Staff will periodically submit for Board consideration plans for facilities improvement, additions, and use.

These plans will be subject to systematic study, revision, and extension from time to time, and the respective construction projects will be acted upon individually when proposed for implementation.

The Board's building use plan will be designed to provide adequate facilities to conduct full-time elementary and secondary education programs for all pupils located in the School District of Brodhead. The building plans will be based upon specific Board actions, which have been and will continue to be modified to conform to changes in the curriculum, availability of space, and changes in enrollments.

The School District shall not discriminate in facility planning or use on the basis of any protected category under Wisconsin or Federal Statute. Equal but separate locker rooms, showers and toilets for males and females will be provided.
