

ORGANIZATION OF INSTRUCTION

Type of Organization

The educational services of the school system shall be organized and maintained as a unified program of instruction, to be operated as a single system under the direction of the Superintendent of Schools. Although the schools shall operate as a single system, it shall be diversified to meet the community's educational needs and the varying individual needs of children and youth.

Scope of Instructional Services

1. The instructional program of the school system shall provide instruction suited to and open to all persons legally eligible to attend school in the District.
2. The program of instruction shall be organized into schools. The Schools of the District shall consist of an elementary school, a middle school, and a senior high school.
  - a. The elementary school shall provide for the instruction in grades EC-5.
  - b. The middle school shall provide instruction for pupils in grades 6, 7, and 8.
  - c. The senior high school shall provide instruction for pupils in grades 9, 10, 11, and 12.

The program of instruction in the schools shall meet standards prescribed by the statutes. Other curriculum shall be planned and maintained to fit the purposes and needs of individual pupils and individual schools.
