GRADING SYSTEMS

It shall be the policy of the School District to evaluate student achievement in grades 4K through 12. The issuance of grades on a regular basis serves to:

- a) promote a process of continuous evaluation of student performance;
- b) inform the student and his/her parent(s) or guardian of the student's progress;
- c) provide a basis for bringing about change in student performance, if such change is deemed necessary.

Specific grading systems shall be developed for various grade levels by the building principal and his/her staff.

The School District shall not discriminate on the basis of any protected category under Wisconsin or Federal Statute.
