

COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE AGES

Students are required to attend school regularly during the full period and hours that school is in session from 6-18 years of age. No child shall be admitted to the first grade unless he/she is six (6) years or older on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the year he/she proposes to enter first grade, or has been approved for early admission by the Board. No child may withdraw from school prior to the age of 18, except under the conditions specified in Wis. St. 118.15.

The building principals are designated truant officers for their respective buildings. Principals will monitor student attendance and take appropriate actions, in cooperation with other agencies, to promote and enforce the compulsory attendance law.
