

PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS

All students entering kindergarten or ninth grade in the School District of Brodhead shall be required to have a physical examination by a physician or other qualified health care professional. A dental examination shall be required for all students entering kindergarten. A vision examination is strongly recommended. If there is a conflict with a student's religious or personal convictions, these examinations may be waived by providing a statement to this effect signed by the parent/guardian. This statement will be kept on file in the school nurse's office.

Physical examinations shall be required every two years for students participating in interscholastic athletics. Athletic physicals for ninth graders may be taken at the same time as the ninth grade physical examination. Both the WIAA physical form and the Ninth Grade physical form need to be completed and signed by the physician. Forms are available in the school offices. Physical examinations for WIAA requirements taken after April 1 are valid for the following two school years, those taken before April 1, are only valid for the remainder of that school year and the following school year.
