

COUNSELING PROGRAM

A continuous program of school counseling services shall be maintained in grades 4K through twelve. The program shall be designed to:

1. Help each student develop an understanding of his/her particular strengths and weaknesses, and assist him/her to develop into a responsible citizen.
2. Help each student relate his/her interests, aptitudes and abilities to a meaningful program of studies and extra-curricular activities.
3. Assist the student in vocational and educational planning.
4. Assist each student with personal concerns.

Principals and school counselors shall be responsible for the screening of all new students, the maintenance of student records, the testing program and student scheduling.

The counseling program shall be evaluated periodically. The School District shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for counseling, evaluating and testing students on the basis of any protected category under Wisconsin or Federal statutes.
