

STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE

1. Cars, motorcycles or other powered vehicles driven to school by the student shall be parked in the school parking lot and shall not be moved until the school is dismissed unless, at the request of the parent, permission is given by the principal. All vehicles shall be parked in the designated parking areas. Parking on the grass or other prohibited areas may result in revocation of parking privileges.

2. Students shall not at any time during the school day, including the noon hour, ride in cars driven by other than their parents unless specific permission is granted by the principal.

3. All vehicles must be properly registered, and driving is permitted only by properly licensed drivers. All posted speed limits and other motor vehicle laws must be obeyed. Violations will result in the loss of parking privileges and/or police referral.

4. Vehicles are subject to search by school administration when there is reasonable suspicion that the student has violated school policy or the law, or is in possession of prohibited items. Administrators may request police assistance as they deem appropriate to the situation.

5. The District assumes no liability or responsibility for damage to, or theft of or from, any vehicle parked on school property.
